## **NEW JUDGE CARL PHILLIPS CHOOSES EDUARDO C. CORRAL AS 2011 YALE YOUNGER POET**

New Haven—Yale University Press is pleased to announce a winner in the 2011 Yale Series of Younger Poets competition. The judge, prize-winning and critically acclaimed poet Carl Phillips, has chosen Eduardo C. Corral's manuscript, **Border with Violin**. Yale University Press will publish Corral's book in April 2012. The manuscript is Phillips's first selection as judge. His predecessor, Louise Glück, selected her eighth and final winner last year: Katherine Larson's Radial Symmetry, which will be published April 19th, 2011.

Eduardo C. Corral is a CantoMundo fellow. He's a graduate of Arizona State University and the Iowa Writers' Workshop. His work has appeared in *The Nation*, *New England Review*, and *Ploughshares*. He lives in southern Arizona.

Awarded since 1919, the Yale Series of Younger Poets prize celebrates the most prominent new American poets by bringing the work of these artists to the attention of the larger public. Earlier winners of the prize include such talents as Adrienne Rich, John Ashberry, and Robert Hass. It is the longest-running poetry prize in the United States.
