English spelling of names on the map include those for the following (from northeast to southwest)

Hā'ěrbīn; Chángchūn; Shěnyáng; Nánjīng; Xī'ān; Chéngdū; Guǎngzhōu.

Wūlǔmùqí is in the far northwest; Lāsà is a long way directly south of Wūlǔmùqí; Hūhéhàotè is west of Beijing, north of the Yellow River; Xīníng is between Lanzhou and Yumen (in the northwest); Dàlǐ is west of Kunming (in the southwest); Guìlín is between Chongqing and Guangzhou (in the south).
